Neighbours will be people who want to meet new people.




Neighbours will go to fortnightly sessions.

Neighbours will learn about working in a theatre.

Neighbours will get free tickets to some theatre shows at Kiln.

They will help audience members who attend the performances and answer their questions.




Neighbours will hand out brochures.


